

The Suffolk Coastal Sports Awards 2010

The fourth annual Coastal Sports Alliance Sports Awards will be held on Sunday 19th September 2010 in recognition of the sporting success and contribution of many different individuals and organisations within the district.

In order to qualify for the awards the individual must currently reside in the Suffolk Coastal District or the Club that they are involved in must be based within the District.

Awards and Award Criteria

	Sports Personality of the Year – Awarded to someone who has achieved great personal sporting success over the past 12 months. This success may have been as an individual or as a significant member of a team
	Young Sports Personality of the Year – Awarded to someone aged under 18 on the 31 st August 2010 whom has achieved a great deal of success in their chosen sport over the past 12 months.
	Disabled Sports Person of the Year – Awarded to someone with a Disability, who has achieved a high level of sporting success over the past 12 months. This success could include overcoming significant barriers and be achieved individually or as a significant member of a team.
	Club of the Year – Awarded to a local club that has achieved a high level of success through its development of areas (i.e. New Youth Section / Expansion of Teams) within the club and encouraged a large number of the local community into their sport.
	Team of the Year – Awarded to a team that has been highly successful over the past 12 months. This may include a consistently high level performance throughout the year or one-off outstanding performance at the highest level.
	Coach of the Year – Awarded to a person that has achieved considerable success through coaching. The coach should hold a recognised National Governing Body Qualification and is committed to providing the highest standard of coaching.
	Sport School of the Year – Awarded to a Primary School that provides it's students with the best opportunities to participate in high quality Physical Education and extra-curricular sport and is committed to school-club links.
	Volunteer of the year Award – Awarded to an individual that has given up their spare time in order to aid the development of others through sport within the community. This could be as a fundraiser, an official, an organiser or a committee member.
	Lifetime Achievement Award – Awarded to an individual that has shown a commendable commitment to community sport within Suffolk Coastal over a number of years. This could be as part of one club / sport or many sports throughout the district.
