



Martello tower glimpsed between Slaughden hulls

Aldeburgh Marshes

Length: 5.5 km
Duration: 1 hour
Start: Slaughden Quay Car Park, Aldeburgh.
 (Landranger TM463554)

Refreshments are available at pubs, restaurants and cafes along Aldeburgh High Street.

Directions

1. From the Slaughden Quay car park, climb onto the sea wall and walk south along the shingle spit to the Martello tower.
2. Make a circuit of the tower and return along the spit to the point where a fingerpost indicates a footpath running west along the river wall.
3. Follow this footpath path along the river's edge.
4. Leave the river wall when the path turns right near Cob Island and head inland towards Aldeburgh.
5. Where the path crosses a track, go straight ahead and do not take the path that runs off to your right.
6. Turn right when you come to a T-junction at the edge of Aldeburgh.
7. Join Priors Hill Road and go straight on until Park Road joins the High Street.
8. Turn right onto Slaughden Road and follow this all the way back to the car park.
