## STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

**Title of the document:** Statement of Community Involvement

**Subject matter and area of the document:** The Statement of Community Involvement details Suffolk Coastal District Council's policy for involving the community in the production of the Local Development Framework and on planning applications made under this. The Statement applies to the entire Suffolk Coastal district.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court (under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004) for permission to seek judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. Any challenge to this decision must be made on the grounds that the document has not been made in accordance with the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively, that a requirement of the Act or associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any such challenge must be made within three months after the date of adoption set out above.
