The Awards recognise the achievements of individuals and groups through Sport, across the Suffolk Coastal District. In order to qualify for the awards the individual must either currently reside in the Suffolk Coastal District or the Club/ Project that they are involved in be based within the District.

Awards and Award Criteria

 Wolsey Volkswagen	<p>Wolsey Volkswagen Sports Personality of the Year – Awarded to someone who has achieved great personal sporting success over the past 12 months. This success may have been as an individual or as a significant member of a team</p>
	<p>BT Young Sports Personality of the Year – Awarded to someone aged under 18 on the 31st August 2011 who has achieved a great deal of success in their chosen sport over the past 12 months.</p>
	<p>EDF Energy Disability Sports Personality of the Year – Awarded to someone with a Disability, who has achieved a high level of sporting success over the past 12 months. This success could include overcoming significant barriers and be achieved individually or as a significant member of a team.</p>
	<p>Spa Pavilion Club of the Year – Awarded to a local club that has achieved a high level of success through its development of areas (i.e. New Youth Section / Expansion of Teams) within the club and encouraged a large number of the local community into their sport.</p>
	<p>Thorpeness & Aldeburgh Hotels Sports Primary School of the Year – Awarded to a Primary School that provides its students with the best opportunities to participate in high quality Physical Education and extra-curricular sport and is committed to school-club links.</p>
	<p>DC Leisure Team of the Year – Awarded to a team that has been highly successful over the past 12 months. This may include a consistently high level performance throughout the year or one-off outstanding performance at the highest level.</p>
	<p>Suffolk Sport Coach of the Year – Awarded to a person who has achieved considerable success through coaching. The coach should hold a recognised National Governing Body Qualification and be committed to providing the highest standard of coaching.</p>
	<p>UCS School of Science, Technology & Health Sports High School of the Year – Awarded to a High School that provides its students with the best opportunities to participate in high quality Physical Education and extra-curricular sport and is committed to school-club links.</p>
	<p>Coastal Sports Alliance Volunteer of the year Award – Awarded to an individual who has given up their spare time in order to aid the development of others through sport within the community. This could be as a fund-raiser, an official, an organiser or a committee member.</p>
	<p>Deben Radio Lifetime Achievement Award – Awarded to an individual who has shown a commendable commitment to community sport within Suffolk Coastal over a number of years. This could be as part of one club / sport or many sports throughout the district.</p>
