Butley Corners & Burrow Hill

Length: 8 km
Duration: 2 hours
Start: Butley Low Corner (Landranger TM381497)

Refreshments are not available along this walk. In Butley, about 2km north of the Priory, Butley Barns Tea Room on Mill Lane and The Oyster Inn on The Street serve food. At the start, only street parking is available.

Directions

1. From Butley Low Corner follow the track north east with the woods to your left until you reach the peak of Burrow Hill.
2. Where the path joins the road, turn left down to the ferry crossing over Butley Creek and look northwards up the river and across the marshes. This is the smallest licensed ferry in Europe.
3. Retrace your steps to where the path joined the track but now continue straight on through Butleyferry Farm to the road.
4. Turn right into Capel St Andrew and right again in the village along the road back towards Butley.
5. Follow the road round to the left, and then sharp right by the farm.
6. Turn right at the crossroads towards Low Corner.

Between April and September, if you want to take the ferry across the river you must phone 01394 450843 or 07913 672499 to book a crossing.
