Description	Constructed in 1891 by the Great Eastern Railway. It has special architectural interest in its design and quality consisting of string coursing, stone details, rubbed brick round-headed arches, fishscale tile hanging to gables, plain tile roof and original cast iron rainwater goods.

Condition	Poor
Priority	A
Reason for Risk	Roof covering failing causing ingress of water. Vacant

Notes	It is likely to be the only surviving country station built by the former Great Eastern Railway in Suffolk. Under threat of possible demolition.
