1. An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for the said Constituency.
2. Nomination papers may be obtained, during normal office hours, from the Acting Returning Officer at the address shown below.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at the offices of Suffolk Coastal District Council, at the address shown below, on any day after the date of this notice, during normal office hours but Not later than 4pm on - Tuesday, 20th April 2010.
4. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 6th May 2010 between the hours of 7 am and 10 pm
5. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender or by means of a banker's draft.
6. Electors should take note that the deadline for new applications to vote by post or to change existing postal or proxy arrangements e.g. cancellation or re-direction etc must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown below by 5pm on Tuesday, 20th April 2010 if they are to be effective for this election.
7. New applications to vote by proxy must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday, 27th April 2010.
8. The deadline for new applications to be received by the Electoral Registration Officer to vote by proxy on grounds of a medical emergency is not later than 5pm on Thursday, 6th May 2010
