



Chantry Marshes by Brinkley's oyster hut

Orford

Length: 6 km
Duration: 1.5 hours
Start: Market Hill, Orford (Landranger TM421499)

Refreshments are available from The Crown and Castle restaurant, The Butley Oysterage restaurant, and the Kings Head pub on the market square, the Jolly Sailor Inn on Quay Street and the Riverside Tearoom on Orford Quay.

Directions

1. From Market Hill, walk north along High Street. Turn right opposite house number 25 and follow this lane to the T-junction with Daphne Road.
2. Turn left and turn right just beyond High House.
3. Cross a drainage ditch to your right and continue towards the river and up to the top of the river wall.
4. Turn right along the wall, descend wooden steps on the left to the Quay where you will find an Ebb and Flow listening post near the tearoom.
5. Join the river shore beyond the tiled shelter and rejoin the river wall path all the way round Chantry Point to the place where the footpath turns away from the river onto a track.
6. Turn right and follow this to the Gedgrave Road. At the road turn right and take the first turning on the left.
7. Turn right onto a footpath across the fields towards the castle. Cross the scrubby rough ground immediately south of the castle and turn left up the road into the market square where this walk began.

For shorter walks follow the dashed lines.
