Description	Large early C19 post mill in centre of village. 3 storey weatherboarded buck on 3 storey painted brick roundhouse. Last worked by engine power in 1966. Now disused but machinery largely intact.
Suggested/Favoured Use	Preserve as mill
Condition	Poor
Priority for Action	A
Reason for Risk	Repairs required to trestle. Water ingress through holes cut in boarding. Lack of strategy to secure future restoration and maintenance.

Current Availability	Not for sale
Notes	In 2004 an external steel frame was erected around the Mill allowing the buck to be supported independently of the weakened trestle, and enabling future repairs to the trestle to be carried out. Owner looking to carry out works to recover the top of the buck to prevent water penetration through the upper surface in 2009, with possible grant aid from SCC and SCDC. On English Heritage's Heritage at Risk Register 2008.
