Description	Ruins of convent of Franciscan friars, comprising walling enclosing an area of just over 7 acres, 2 gateways to the west and a small fragment of one of the monastic buildings. Founded here after 1289; surviving remains probably late C14. The boundary wall is fragmentary in places.

Condition	Very bad

Reason for Risk	Precinct walls overgrown with ivy. Evidence of burrowing animals. East wall succumbing to coastal erosion.
