**The Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of
Community Governance) Order 2010**

Made on the 29th day of January 2010

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

In October 2005, Suffolk Coastal District Council (“the Council”) concluded a parish review under s9 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997. An order to give effect to that review was submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation in December 2005. In November 2008, the Secretary of State agreed with the Council in accordance with paragraph 10 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (Commencement No. 3, Transitional and Saving Provisions and Commencement No. 2 (Amendment) Order 2008 that the review should be treated as if it constituted recommendations made in a community governance review under section 86 of the Local Government and Public Involvement (“the 2007 Act”):

On 25 June 2009 the Council resolved to approve the boundary review undertaken in 2005 and decided to give effect to those recommendations as if they constituted recommendations made in accordance with a community governance review under section 86 of the 2007 Act and, in doing so has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf..

Citation and commencement(a)

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2009.

(2) It shall come into force on 1st April 2010.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“district” means the district of Suffolk Coastal District Council

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“existing boundary” means the existing boundary between the parishes of Kesgrave and Rushmere St. Andrew as delineated in red on the Map

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2009” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

“new boundary” means the new boundary between the parishes of Kesgrave and Rushmere St. Andrew as delineated in blue on the Map.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Alteration of parish areas and the areas of parish wards

4.—(1) The areas hatched and designated by the letters “A” and “B” on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Kesgrave and Kesgrave West Ward of that parish and shall become part of the parish of Rushmere St. Andrew and Rushmere Ward of that parish, as detailed in Schedule 1 hereto.

Electoral register

5. The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Order date

6. 1st April 2010 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
