



Notice to Persons Being Interviewed

1. This interview is being conducted in accordance with the Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 Code of Practice for the treatment and questioning of persons.
2. This interview is to enable you to offer an explanation of the facts, though should evidence of an offence emerge you may be prosecuted.
3. You do not have to say anything, but it may harm your defence if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in Court. Anything you do say may be given in evidence.
4. You are not under arrest or detained here; you may leave at any time during the interview. If the interview is being conducted in your home, you may ask the officer(s) conducting the interview to leave at any time.
5. You may have a friend with you if you wish.
6. You may have a lawyer and / or an interpreter with you if you wish, in which case this interview will be suspended until another interview can be arranged.
7. You may seek legal advice at any time.
8. A copy of the code of practice is available if you wish to consult it.
