support each other and work together...

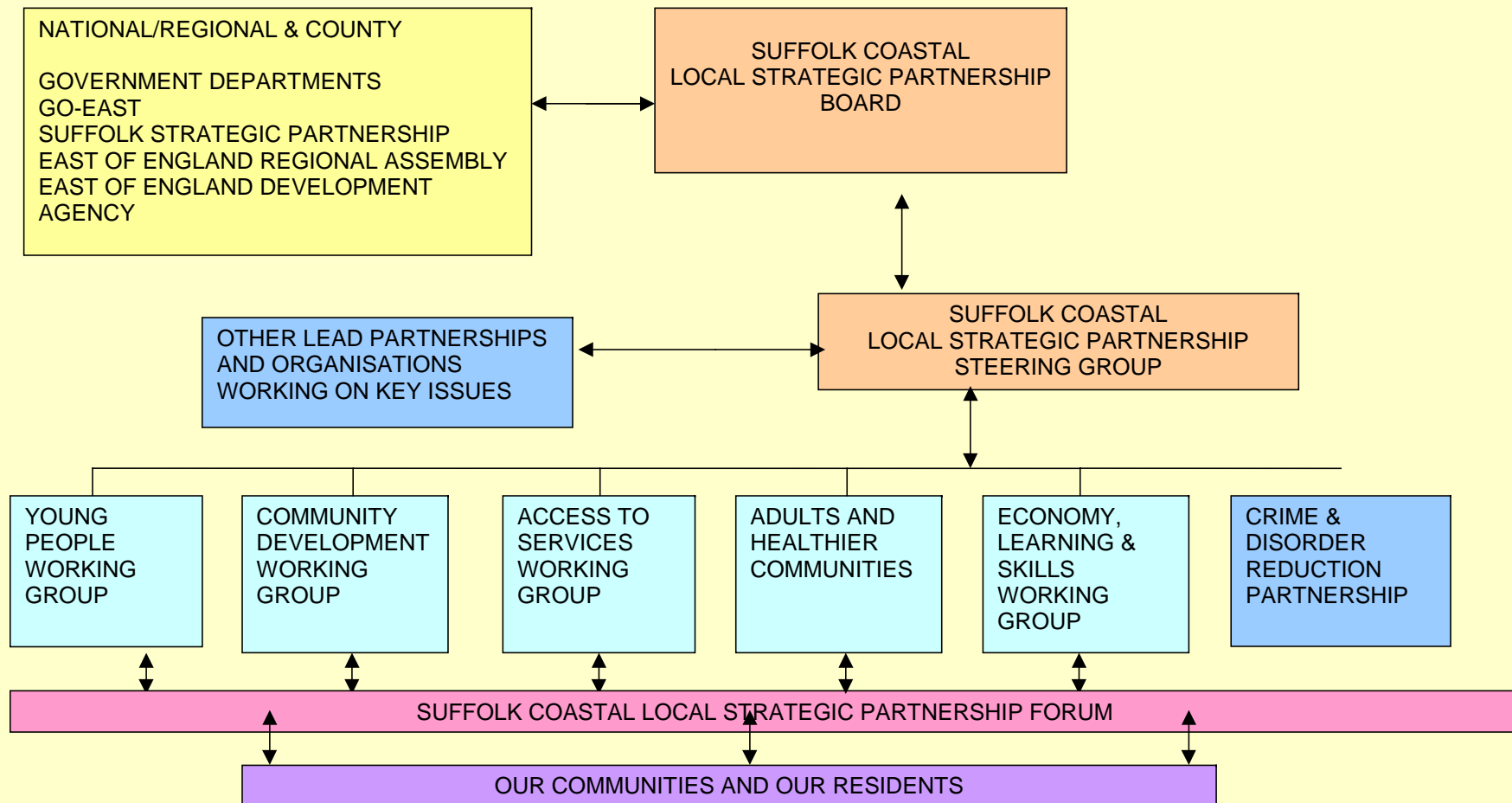
What do LSPs do ?
